SUPPLEMENTARY DECISION

This is an Ontario-based Claimant, claim # 4155

- 1. In this claim, I issued a decision on October 16, 2006, in which the Claimants were given one month to indicate clearly in writing that they do have evidence to proceed with the claim or that they do not have such evidence to proceed with the claim.

At the hearing of this matter on December 19, 2006, the Claimants indicated that they did not have any evidence, and understood that the claim would be dismissed. Based on the fact that there was no evidence called and no response to my decision of October 16, 2006, the claim is hereby dismissed.
