ORDER

THIS MOTION made by the Joint Committee for an order extending the date

for the filing of the triennial financial sufficiency review motion for the period ended

December 31, 2022 and rescinding the Court-Approved Protocol - Temporary Measures

Related to the COVID-19 Pandemic was heard in writing this day.

ON READING the material filed including the notice of motion and affidavit

of Heather Rumble Peterson sworn June 21, 2023,

AND ON BEING ADVISED that this motion is on consent of the Plaintiffs,

Canada and that the Intervenors and Ontario takes no position,

1. THIS COURT ORDERS that the date by which the financial sufficiency review motion is to be made pursuant to Article 10.01(1)(i) of the January 1, 1986 - July 1, 1990 Hepatitis C Settlement Agreement for the three (3) year period ended December 31, 2022 be and is hereby extended to November 30, 2023.

THIS COURT ORDERS that effective 12:01 am EDT August 1, 2023;

- (a) the Court-Approved Protocol - Temporary Measures Related to the COVID-19 Pandemic shall no longer be in force and effect, except as hereinafter provided;
- (b) the timeline provided for Tracebacks pursuant to the mandatory timeline requirement of section 5(b) of the Court-Approved Protocol - Traceback Procedure Criteria shall resume running; and
- (c) extensions of time to take any action required by the Plans created under the 1986-1990 Hepatitis C Settlement Agreement may only be granted to class members or claimants who had applied pursuant to the Protocol - Temporary Measures Related to the COVID-19 Pandemic prior to August 1, 2023.

3. THIS COURT ORDERS that a notice be posted on the 1986 – 1990 Hepatitis C Class Action Settlement Website and the HCV Late Claims Benefit Plan Website for at least two (2) weeks prior to August 1, 2023 advising that the Protocol - Temporary Measures Related to the COVID-19 Pandemic will no longer be in force and effect, except as it pertains to applications for extension of deadlines made before that date.

4. THIS COURT DECLARES that the terms of this Order shall not be effective unless and until companion orders are issued by the Superior Court of Québec and the Supreme Court of British Columbia with no material difference.
